Beginning (2)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I arrive on time with the right clothing (indoor/outdoor) • I try to use the skills I have learned, but only when the play comes to me (standing waiting for play) <li style="text-align: center;">OR • I'm not really into the game- often I cause disruptions in game flow because I'm fooling around or off task • I would rather socialize with just my friends in class • I follow the safety rules • I need to be asked more than once to help to with equipment
Needs Work (1)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I MAY have arrived without proper clothing and need to be reminded to find proper clothing • I do not try to use skills or tactics I have learned or move with the play <li style="text-align: center;">OR • I treat others with disrespect (for example: switching teams, making fun) • I use inappropriate language for example: (swearing, hurtful comments) • I follow the safety rules • I do not help with equipment
